THE 15 GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The gifts of the Holy Spirit are ministry gifts. The condition for receiving them is that, a person must be born again and Baptized in the Holy Spirit. No one can have any of the gifts without receiving the Giver, the Holy Spirit. While most people quote 1st Corinthians when referring to the gifts, there are really two lists; the other being found in the Book of Romans.

1 THE WORD OF WISDOM

The word of wisdom is a problem solving gift. We can neither demand nor orchestrate it, but we may ask for it. It is the Holy Spirit's prerogative to determine when, where and how it will be used. In times of crisis, the Holy Spirit may reveal to a person with this gift, how to solve the problem for someone who wouldn't normally know what to do.

2 THE WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

This gift of the Holy Spirit is used to express what God wants to do amongst us and allows the person who has the gift to participate in His work. It is knowledge about something God is doing, wants to do, or is about to do at that moment of time. As with all the gifts, it cannot be acquired by study, learning or by observation.

3 THE GIFT OF FAITH

The gift of faith is a sudden, complete trust, accompanied with total confidence in Jesus Christ, the Bible and all its promises. This gift does not waver with the ups and downs that characterize the typical or ordinary Christian walk. "Faith people" know that there is nothing that God can't do and won't do, if the conditions of the scriptures are met.

4 THE WORD OF HEALING

Being one of the most desired gifts, the gifts of healing are important gifts because people's lives depend on them. Those who possess it, have a responsibility to make themselves available to pray for those who are sick, offering to pray in all situations and in all conditions.

5 THE GIFT OF MIRACLES

One of the most spectacular gifts of the Holy Spirit, miracles can be translated as "works of power", or "activities that call forth miracles." It is the gift of energizing power, and through it, the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit is applied to natural situations resulting in miracles.

6 THE GIFT OF PHOPHECY

God never does anything without telling His prophets what He is going to do before He does it (Amos 3:7). The word, "prophecy" refers to a revelation that is hidden, or a foretelling of the future under the authority of divine guidance. A person with this gift, will receive messages from Jesus inspired by the Holy Spirit, and in turn, he/she is responsible to deliver it to the appropriate church or individual(s).

7 THE GIFT OF DISCERNING OF SPIRITS

A person with this gift is enabled to tell the difference between things and people who are from God, and things and people who are from the Devil, thus giving him/her a starting point from which to either root the enemy, or seek God for protection. This gift provides protection against false prophets, false teachers, false doctrine, the works of sin, the works of Satan and the work of evil spirits (demons).

8 THE GIFT OF SPEAKING IN TONGUES

The gift of tongues represents the Lordship of Jesus over our lives. It poses the greatest threat to self-control because it exercises God-control over our tongues. Tongues simply translated is "speaking in other national languages," and represents those who are baptized in the Holy Spirit. It is a sign (Mark 16:17) for believers that those who possess it, are born again and Spirit-filled.

9 THE GIFT OF INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES

The gift of tongues and of interpretation, together, form God's communication system to us and the church. It first appeared on the Day of Pentecost and will be in effect until Jesus returns. This gift manifests itself in different ways to those who possess it. Some hear a quiet voice, others see the words in their mind, while others claim the Holy Spirit shows them impressions.

10 THE GIFT OF SERVICE

The gift of service is gift of practical help. Those who possess it have the ability to see things that need to be done in one's everyday life. They are able to keep the balance between knowing when to spend time in worship and prayer, and when to get the practical things done like housework, cleaning, shopping, etc.

11 THE GIFT OF GIVING

The gift of giving is where the Holy Spirit points out to the person possessing the gift, people who require help, such as food, clothing, housing, transportation, the basic necessities of life. It may involve helping to support Christians who require financial or other types of assistance in their ministries. The Holy Spirit will reveal what and how much to give. The person with the gift responds in simple obedience and no questions are asked.

12 THE GIFT OF TEACHING

The gift of teaching is the supernatural ability to explain the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Those exploring Christianity, as well as Christians in various stages of growth, need those who are equipped with this special gift to explain the simplicity and depth of the Gospel message.

13 THE GIFT OF EXHORTATION

People who have the gift do not usually stand out from the crowd. They are with the eyes of Jesus and appear to be shy, quiet people with a knowing what-you-are-supposed-to-do kind of look. They smile with a gentle certainty. They take people who are struggling with God's call aside and encourage them to move ahead with His plan for their life. When it is necessary to encourage a church to get on with God's vision, they step forward with the boldness of the Holy Spirit before the entire congregation declaring whatever He gives them to say. They are God's greatest encouragers.

14 THE GIFT OF CONTRIBUTING AID

This gift is referred to as the gift of leadership or aid (Romans 12:6). People who have this gift have the ability to organize and assist the different ministries that are being developed by their churches. They are key in helping leadership to achieve the vision that God has given.

15 THE GIFT OF MERCY

People who have been given this supernatural gift never tire of caring for broken people especially the sick, suffering and dying. They do not judge; they save, minister, heal and watch over the people that others ignore. The homeless, runaways, drunkards on the street, abandoned seniors in nursing homes, etc. all are precious to them.
