

Dominion Theology vs Kingdom Theology

Dominion more emphasizes our human delegated role to conquer own and rule over people places and things.

Kingdom Theology is more about God's sovereign rule over His subjects based on His values.

Gen 1:28 “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

1 John 5:4 – For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the **victory that has overcome** the world—our faith.

Deut 28:2-8 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the Lord your God. ³ Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the field. ⁴ Blessed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock. ⁵ Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. ⁶ Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out. ⁷ “The Lord will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before you. They shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways. ⁸ The Lord will command the blessing on you in your barns and in all that you undertake. And he will bless you in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

Luke 10:19 - Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.

Matt 7:12 - So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.

Matt 6:10 – Your kingdom come,
your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Rom 12:7-9 – Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them... in proportion to our faith; ⁷ if service, in our serving; the one who teaches, in his teaching; ⁸ the one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness.

Function... from one to another...

Kingdom 1. Spiritual gift - - priesthood of believer - kingdom life

The thought is - God has given us spiritual gifts to serve Him and others, serve directly and responsibly, and only for His glory and benefit.

Dominion 1. Conversion – acquire possession - take authority

The thought is – God has chosen us to be first, best and most so that we can acquire and use people places and things to rule.
